

Western Sydney Stadium

Project update – August 2018



The NSW Government is building a new stadium for Western Sydney. It is now over 70 percent complete and on track to be open in 2019. Once built, this exciting stadium is set to revolutionise the spectator experience and inject millions of dollars into the local economy.

Construction progress

The new Western Sydney Stadium is taking shape with the roof installation over the Western Grandstand well underway. Inside the bowl, fitout works in the Grandstand are progressing and the food and beverage outlets and amenities along the concourse are also commencing construction. Every day, there are over 360 workers on site working hard to deliver this world-class venue for Western Sydney.

Work over the next three months will include:

- completing the upper bowl structure
- progressing the lower bowl structure
- completing the roof structure
- installing the stadium seating bracketry and handrails
- building and fitout of concourse amenities and food & beverage outlets
- installing services and fitout of the western grandstand
- commencing the external civil and landscape works.

Community update

Western Sydney Stadium celebrates key milestone

On 14 June 2018, construction of the Western Sydney Stadium reached a significant milestone, celebrating the topping out of the new stadium.

The event was held to celebrate the completion of the Western Grandstand structure. Members of the Lendlease delivery team were joined by the Minister for Sport and Member for Seven Hills.

O'Connell Street car park partial closure

As part of construction works to deliver the Western Sydney Stadium, upgrades in the O'Connell Street car park commenced on 14 July 2018. The upgrades will improve lighting and pedestrian and vehicle access in the car park.

To carry out the work, a small number of car park spaces have been closed and alternative access routes in and out of the car park are in place until the new stadium opens in mid-2019.
