

## Have your say

The Blackwattle Bay State Significant Precinct Study (SSP Study) is on public exhibition until Friday 6 August 2021.

Anyone can make a submission in any language. The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) will collate submissions and publish them on their website. Infrastructure NSW will review all submissions and prepare a Response to Submissions Report (RtS) to respond to the issues raised. The RtS will be available on the DPIE website.

## Planning process

- Minister for Planning determines:
  - > that it is a matter of state or regional environmental planning significance
  - > the public consultation requirements
- Department issues State Significant Precinct study requirements
- A State Significant Precinct study is prepared including proposed planning framework
- WE ARE HERE** Department co-ordinates Public Exhibition
- A response to submissions is prepared
- Department's recommendation and draft SEPP and maps submitted to Minister
- Minister for Planning determines planning framework

Write a letter to:

Your letter must include:

1. Your name and address, at the top of the letter
2. A statement on whether you support or object to the proposed planning controls
3. The reasons why you support or object to the planning controls
4. A declaration of any reportable political donations.

If you are lodging your submission by post and do not want your name published, please state this clearly at the top of your submission. If you are lodging your submission online, follow the prompts on the planning portal to indicate you do not want your name published.
