Construction of Temporary Site Amenities

Dear Neighbour,

The NSW Government is delivering a new Sydney Fish Market which will retain its authentic experience and strengthen its position as one of Australia's leading tourist destinations.

Upcoming works

On **Wednesday 20 April**, construction will begin on a temporary facility to provide amenities for construction workers within the grounds of Sydney Secondary College at Glebe. The facility will take approximately three months to establish and will be removed on completion of the project.

The temporary facility will consist of double stacked site sheds on a raised steel gantry. Direct access for workers to the project site will be provided via a raised steel bridge above the Glebe foreshore walk.

Hours of work

The facility will be established during approved project hours 7:00am-5:30pm Monday to Friday and 7:30am-3:30pm Saturday.

Community Impacts

- Pedestrian access will be maintained, with minor changes to access along Bridge Road and the Glebe foreshore walk at limited times during construction of the amenities facility. Traffic control and temporary diversions in place when necessary.
- This work has been planned in close consultation with Sydney Secondary College and will have minimal impact on students or staff.
