### Bridge Road geotechnical investigation

Dear neighbour

The NSW Government is delivering a new Sydney Fish Market which will retain its authentic experience and strengthen its position as one of Australia's leading tourist destinations.

#### **Upcoming work –Investigation work along Bridge Road**

Investigation work is required along Bridge Road to test existing ground conditions which will inform utility services foundation design for the Bridge Road upgrade works in 2023.

Work will take place on **Thursday 2 June** between **10am and 3pm**. Work is anticipated to take one day to complete, subject to authority approvals and fine weather conditions.

The location of the work is along the eastbound lanes of Bridge Road, between Wentworth Park Road and Wattle Street (Refer to Figure 1 overleaf).

#### **How this affects you**

The work will require closure of one eastbound traffic lane along Bridge Road. Vehicles and cyclists will be diverted around the work zone by traffic controllers. There will be no impact to pedestrian access. Physical barriers will be placed between the footpath and each work zone.

The work zones will be removed at the end of the work shift, and travel along the road will continue as normal outside the construction hours.
